

RULES

1. NAME

- 1.1 The name of the Club shall be the SOUTHBOURNE BOWLING CLUB.
- 1.2 The Club colours shall be Red, Navy and Gold.

2. FUNCTIONS

- 2.1 The Men's and Ladies' Committees shall administer all matters to do with Bowling, which includes National, County, District and Club competition entries, team selection, and deal with all matters appertaining to all Friendly matches.

3. CHAIRMANSHIP

All Committees shall be under the Chairmanship of the President or Vice President.

4. MEN'S & LADIES COMMITTEES

- 4.1 Each Committee shall be responsible for team selection and bowling administration.
- 4.2 The Men's Committee will consist of the President (or Vice President), Men's Captain (or nominated person), Competition Secretary, B. & D. B. A. League Team Captains and three elected members. Five shall form a Quorum. If the President or Vice President are not available to attend for any reason the Captain (or nominated person) on that Committee shall assume the responsibility of Chairperson.
- 4.2A The Ladies Committee will consist of the President (or Vice President) Ladies Captain (or nominated person), Competition Secretary and Four elected members. Five shall form a Quorum. If the President or Vice President are not available to attend for any reason the Captain (or nominated person) on that Committee shall assume the responsibility of Chairperson.
- 4.3 The Committee members shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Club.
- 4.4 The Committees shall assume responsibility for the administration for the County, B & D.B.A. and B & D.W.B.A. Games and assess club handicaps. The Committees may co-opt other members as required, but co-opted members shall not have a vote.

5. AMENDMENT OF, OR ADDITION TO THE RULES.

No amendment or addition to these rules shall be made except at the Annual General Meeting or at a Special General Meeting called for that purpose and supported by not less than two-thirds of the members voting.

The Secretary shall issue notices at least seven days before the meeting, setting forth any such proposed amendment or addition to the rules, which is to be submitted to the Annual General Meeting of the Club. Such proposed amendments or additions to the Rules must be sent to the General Secretary not later than 30th September for the Annual General Meeting.

DRESS ON THE GREENS

When 'Full Whites' are required this shall mean as designated from time to time by Bowls England (NB 'Full Whites' as required by Bowls England may be amended when playing under the auspices of the Local Associations).

For all other play:

Members should wear white above the waist and grey below. Members may be permitted to wear grey or white shorts with matching socks or tights (optional). For “Roll up’s” smart casual clothing is permitted, however all Club Games including, National, County and B & D Competitions, League Matches and Friendly Matches the dress code will be as laid down above with official Club shirts being worn at all times.

DRESS CODE ON OTHER OCCASIONS

Funerals: For a Guard of Honour at the funeral of a Club Member the full dress of Grey Trousers/Skirt, White Shirt/Blouse with Club Tie/Club Flash, together with Navy Blazer should be worn.

Men attending County or District (B & D) meetings or functions on behalf of the Club should wear Grey Trousers White Shirt with appropriate Club, County or District (B & D) tie and Navy Blazer: Matches – play in ‘Whites’.

Ladies attending County or District (B & D) meetings on behalf of the Club should wear ‘casual’ clothing.

Ladies attending County or District (B & D) formal functions on behalf of the Club should wear White Trousers/Skirt with Club Shirt and Navy Blazer. County Matches: Play in appropriate County Shirt and ‘Whites’. District (B & D) Matches: Play in White Shirt with ‘Whites’.

On any occasion other than above – as designated. If in any doubt please contact appropriate Bowling Committee.
